Moab Regional Hospital is seeking a Clinical Informatics Nurse to join our hospital team. This role is designed for an RN that is highly comfortable with technology of all types and has a passion for ensuring quality patient care through improved technological functionality. This role will be responsible to provide new hire and on-going training to clinical and non-clinical staff as well as providers. MRH uses several electronic medical records (EMRs) and clinical information systems (CISs). This position will be expected to learn the ins and outs of the systems and become a 'super user' so they can provide support to staff and providers through configuration and troubleshooting.

The right candidate is equally comfortable working with technology and people, either one-on-one or in small groups. The position also includes working with non-clinical staff so as to optimize charge capture. This is a full-time (40 hours/week), year-round position.
