General Job Description:

A general psychiatric APRN is needed to join the MRH Mental Health Team. Psychiatric programming has been building over the last year and services have expanded to include the need for a full time psychiatric provider. This provider would carry a diverse patient load and work with interdisciplinary team members including therapy, social work, psychiatry and nursing. This position could be worked 4 or 5 days a week, no call required.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Evaluate and treat psychiatric illness among patients of all ages.
- Advocate for and partner with patients while tracking objective measures.
- Work in consultation and collaboration with primary care to ensure treatment objectives are met.
- Track patient wellbeing through screening tools, office visits, phone follow up.
- Identify obstacles to receiving care and risk factors for patient decompensation.
- Ensure lab work is ordered and followed up with in a timely fashion to ensure patient safety and medication tolerance.
- Assist in educating patients and caretakers on different treatment options.
- Monitor and update treatment plans to reflect latest in patient condition.
- Stay up to date on latest psychiatric treatments.
- Perform as needed community outreach and education around mental health.

Education and Experience:

- Masters or doctorate in nursing.
- Graduation from an accredited PMHNP program.
- At least one year of clinical experience as psychiatric NP desired.
- Supervisory or quality assurance experience valued.
- Experience working with or building new programs valued.
- Strong computer skills for managing data input, tracking patient outcomes, using medical record.
- Experience with screening tools (e.g. PHQ-9, GAD-7) or willingness to be trained.

- Organized and resourceful self-starter; strong ability to work in a team
- Strong interpersonal skills and communication abilities due to nature of liaison work on interdisciplinary team.
