



COVID-19 VACCINATION TIMELINE

LATE DECEMBER – JANUARY

- Healthcare workers who work in high-risk environments
- Remaining healthcare personnel, including: clinics, pharmacy staff, long-term care facilities, assisted living facilities, skilled nursing staff, and other healthcare personnel who are at higher-risk
- School staff
- EMS, First Responders, and public health workers

FEBRUARY

- Long-term care facility staff and residents who have not been vaccinated
- Utahns 75 years of age and older
- Utahns with certain underlying medical conditions

MARCH – JULY

- Tribal reservation communities
- Additional Utahns based on age
- Additional Utahns living in congregate care settings
- Racial and ethnic groups at higher-risk
- All Utahns
