



Physician Assistant (PA) at Moab Regional Urgent Care

The Urgent Care PA is responsible for providing direct patient care to walk-in patients of all ages (infants to geriatrics) in a hospital-based outpatient clinic. This role must be able to effectively diagnose and provide therapeutic treatments for a wide range of patient needs. Our ideal candidate is comfortable working independently and autonomously and uses their critical thinking and troubleshooting skills to quickly assess and begin treatment for patients and/or refer to higher-level care through the on-site Emergency Department. Responsibilities will include the creation of accurate record of physical findings, formulation of treatment plan and prognosis based on patient condition, and the ability to provide home-going instruction. The ability to order, interpret, and evaluate diagnostic tests is essential. This role will also include prescribing and recommending medications or other forms of treatment. Urgent Care is open 1300 to 2000, Monday-Saturday and 1100-1700 Sundays, 365 days/year. This position is full-time, year-round; weekend shifts and some holidays are required.
