Though this position will begin as part-time, more hours will become quickly available with the opportunity to acquire full-time benefits. The Patient Portal Van Driver will be responsible for ensuring the safe transport of Behavioral Health Clinic patients to and from their appointments. The Patient Portal van holds four passengers and one wheelchair. The van driver will report to the Behavioral Health Department manager for schedule, directions, and instructions. The driver will work with the Facilities Manager to maintain vehicle's cleanliness, mechanics and operation.

- Listen to traffic and weather reports to stay up-to-date on road conditions
- Ensure the van seats are clean and comfortable for all riders
- Minimum visual acuity of 20/50 (or corrected to 20/50)
- Able to lift/move up to 30 lbs. without assistance and lift/move weights beyond 30 lbs. with assistance
- Calm, compassionate demeanor with great customer service skills
- Able to work effectively both as part of a small team and independently
- Accurately follow written and/or verbal instructions as well as communicate with others effectively.
- Reliable and timely with work schedule. The position will be primarily located in Moab, though there may be times when transporting patients to/from outside area is required.
- Able to handle stressful situations calmly; emotionally mature. Able to receive and manage sensitive information professionally
- Able to stand, walk, bend, squat, reach, push/pull equipment, and meet other mobility requirements
- Ability to work in a confidential manner
